- 1. **Call to Order:** Hagerty called the meeting to order at 3:11 p.m.

6. **Budget Modifications**: Pfitzinger discussed the funding options for the Health and Sanitation Program. The need for bike racks, special events climate, new public art rebate program and the current staffing models were also presented.

Motion: Move \$30,000 from 1.02 Special Events to 2.13 new line for Public Health and Safety. Merrill motioned, Yang seconded motion. Motion passes.

Motion: Pursue contracts for bike rack installation. Yang motioned, Merrill seconded motion. Motion passes. Motion: Approve temporary contract staff in marketing from 7.02 Personnel in the amount of \$6,967 to 1.10 Temporary Marketing. Merrill motioned, Yang seconded motion. Motion passes.

- 7. **Budget 2021:** Pfitzinger presented the 2021 budget draft. The Commission reviewed each line item. The Commission discussed the 25% changed items in further detail including the new website, increased public relations, next phase of the wayfinding project and staff shifts.
